<p>Fees:*</p>	<p>CAG assesses a total fee of \$15,000 for the submittal, review, and processing of a proposed amendment to the “CAG Section 208 Areawide Water Quality Management Plan (CAG 208 Plan). This fee covers review of the document and the Public Participation Process as outlined in Chapter 5 of the CAG 208 Plan.</p> <p>The fee is broken into three (3) installments:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ \$2,000 Application Fee due upon submittal of application – <i>(Includes Application Meeting & Stakeholder process to determine if Application can move forward for processing)</i> ▪ \$6,500 due upon the receipt of the Draft amendment <i>(after Stakeholder process, but before the Review can begin)</i>. No review of the plan can begin until this installment is remitted. ▪ \$6,500 due prior to scheduling the Public Hearing. <p>The applicant may also elect to pay the entire fee in one installment to prevent any unnecessary delays. – ALL FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE.</p>
<p>Included in the Fee:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ 1 Application meeting. ▪ 1 Stakeholder meeting. ▪ Up to 3 Appeals Process meetings should it be necessary. ▪ Up to 4 Reviews of the Draft 208 Plan Amendment in concert with ADEQ. ▪ 1 Meeting with the CAG Environmental Planning Committee (EPC) to approve moving forward with Public Hearing. ▪ 1 Public Hearing Notice in a local newspaper. ▪ 1 Public Hearing, located near the proposed area, when possible and feasible. ▪ 1 Meeting with the CAG Environmental Planning Committee for Recommendation. ▪ 1 Meeting with the CAG Management Committee for Recommendation. ▪ 1 Meeting with the CAG Regional Council for Approval. ▪ 1 Meeting with the ADEQ State Water Quality Management Working Group for Recommendation. ▪ Submission of final amendment package to ADEQ and/or US EPA
<p>Additional Fees:</p>	<p>Any item outside the above list of services is subject to an additional fee of \$125 per hour, billed monthly. Generally, these costs include extra meetings which require travel, preparation, coordination, additional public notices or public hearings, and/or additional Committee/Council meetings.</p>

Attorney Fees:	Most amendments do not require legal advice. In the event that CAG must use its attorneys due to unusual circumstances, CAG will bill for attorney’s fees at the Attorney’s current rate.
Major Revisions:	In the event that the Regional Council deliberates over your amendment and either denies approval or requests major revisions that require the Draft to go through the Public Process again, your new amendment will be subject to a subsequent \$15,000 fee.
Sunsetting of Application	If no activity occurs on a given application within one-year of the scheduled “Application Meeting” in which the application receives a unique CAG ID number, the application is considered expired, and all Application fees submitted will be surrendered by the applicant. If no activity occurs within one-year after any step of the process due to delays caused by the applicant, the application will be considered abandoned and all fees submitted will be surrendered by the applicant.

***NOTE: ALL FEES ARE SUBJECT TO INCREASE UPON REGIONAL COUNCIL APPROVAL**
