**I. CALL TO ORDER**

The Transportation Technical Advisory Committee (TTAC) meeting was called to order at 10:03 AM by Chairperson, Mr. Travis Ashbaugh.

**II. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE**

Mr. Ashbaugh led the Committee in the Pledge of Allegiance.

**III. ROLL CALL**

Mr. Ashbaugh conducted the roll call and a quorum was established.

**IV. INTRODUCTIONS**

Introductions were made throughout the meeting room and on the phone.

**V. APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Mr. Ashbaugh addressed the Committee and asked whether there were any comments or corrections that needed to be made to the September 10, 2015 TTAC meeting minutes. Mr. Jerry Barnes made a motion to approve the September 10, 2015 TTAC meeting minutes and Ms. Margaret Gaston seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

**VI. STANDING REPORTS**

**A. Member Jurisdictions – TTAC Members**

Mr. Ashbaugh requested that TTAC members provide Project Status reports.

1. Mr. Paul Curzon from the Town of Miami reported that they there is an issue with the 911 system and street signs.
2. Ms. Kerlock from the Town of Winkelman reported that the Street Sign Improvement Project sign inventory has been completed.
3. Mr. Jerry Barnes from the City of Globe reported that the Oak Street Project for FY 2017 is on track, and that the Broad Street Project for FY 2018 is also on track. Mr. Barnes reported that the water line project on US 60 currently underway is on track.
4. Mr. Tom Homan from Gila County had nothing new to report.
5. Ms. Gaston from the Town of Superior reported that the Town has set-up an intergovernmental agreement with the University of Arizona students to perform drainage audit of the drainage issues. The audit will determine the corrective action needed.
6. Mr. Curtis Ward from the Town of Payson reported that the West Longhorn Road and McLane Road round-a-bout project costs are much higher than anticipated. Mr. Ward reported that the Bonita Street design project is complete.
7. Mr. Marvin Mull from San Carlos Apache Tribe reported that work is progressing on the Route 6 turn-lanes. The new elementary school road has been postponed while the Community awaits United States Department of Transportation authorization for funding from the Transportation Investment Generating Economic Recovery (TIGER) Program.
8. Mr. Travis Ashbaugh from Pinal County had nothing new to report.

**B. ADOT Multi-Modal Planning Division – Charla Glendening**

Ms. Charla Glendening from the ADOT Multimodal Planning Division reported that the Superior Planning Assistance for Rural Areas (PARA) Study should be advertised October 22, 2015. Ms. Glendening also reported that the Long Range Transportation Plan has been kicked-off and will be performance based to identify projects.

**C. Local Public Agency – Eric Boyles**

Mr. Eric Boyles had nothing to report to the Committee regarding the Local Public Agency Section.

**D. ADOT Southeast District Engineer – Bill Harmon**

Mr. Bill Harmon of the ADOT South East District provided information to TAC and others present on the reason for ADOT's revised districts.

**E. Sun Corridor MPO – Irene Higgs**

Ms. Higgs reported that the regional transportation plan and safety study were moving forward and on schedule. Ms. Higgs further reported that the transit study is currently on hold until the City of Coolidge's transit study is completed.

**F. Transportation Planning Manager – Andy Smith**

Mr. Smith reported that Northern Arizona Council of Government will be looking to loan \$400,000 in surface transportation funding this fiscal year.

**VII. NEW BUSINESS**

Mr. Smith provided a brief update on the CAG Safety Plan and stated that a draft version will be distributed early next week for review and comment. Mr. Smith provided an update on the FY 2016 5310 award. CAG was awarded FY 2016 5310 mobility management funding.

Mr. Ashbaugh requested whether anyone wished to speak. There were not any requests to speak from members of the public.
